



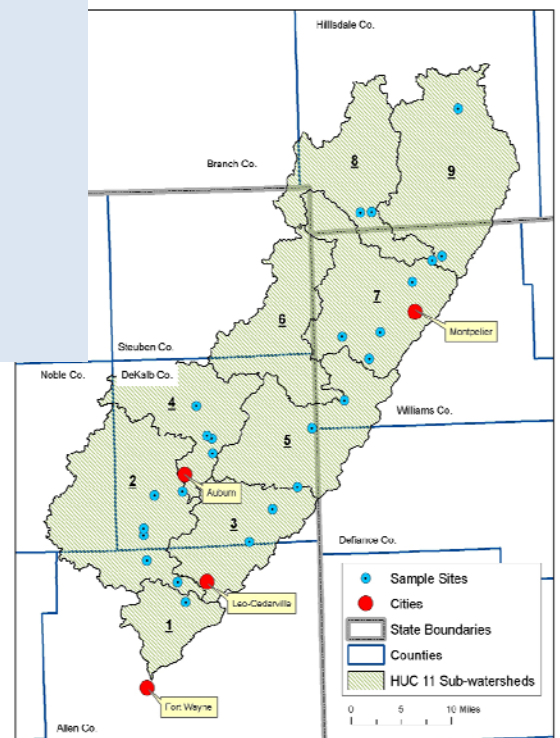
## Water Quality Information Service

The **Water Quality Information Service** is a resource for anyone interested in learning more about water quality in the St. Joseph, St. Marys, Auglaize and Upper Maumee River watersheds. The on-line database brings into one location water quality monitoring data that has been collected by the St. Joseph River Watershed Initiative Partnership and other groups going back to the late 1990s along with data collected by other watershed groups more recently. It is maintained by the St. Joe Initiative in collaboration with the Environmental Resources Center at Indiana University Purdue University Fort Wayne, Fort Wayne City Utilities, the Allen County Soil and Water Conservation District and the Tri-State Watershed Alliance.

Data available:

- 50 sites
- 7 water quality parameters including bacteria, nutrients, and pesticides
- Physical properties
